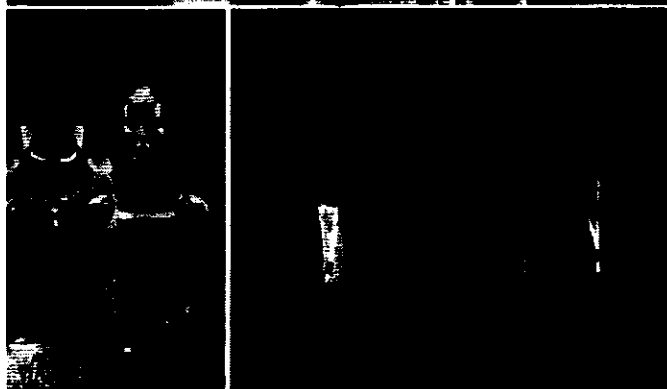
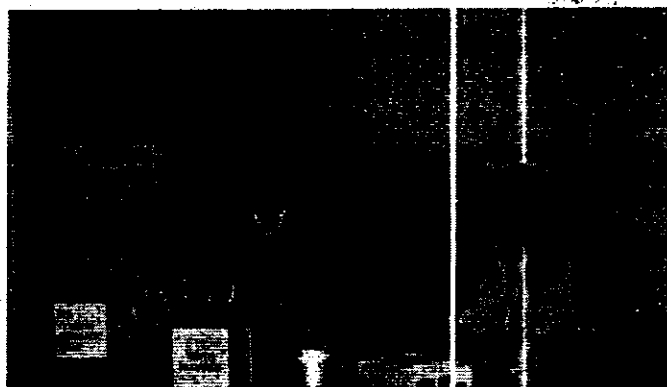

Forward

At the Youth Alliance – Krushevo annual meeting on 12/01/2025, we thoroughly reviewed the activities carried out in 2024 and adopted the annual report. Overall, it was a **productive and busy year filled with both accomplishments and challenges.**

We directly engaged **2.200 young people**, with an additional **20,000** reached indirectly. Our social media channels connected us to **75,555 followers**. The team grew by **2 employees** and **11 new volunteers**. Our 2024 budget increased by **4%** compared to 2023.

Through our work on key strategic projects, we exceeded our goals in some areas. For example, our international youth conference, "European Values for the Future of Southeast Europe 2024," attracted more participants than in previous years, significantly expanding our influence among regional youth leaders.

In contrast, our Bilateral Youth Cooperation project faced challenges due to a lack of political will from both North Macedonia and Greece. Despite this, our project team remains committed and will continue advocating for this important initiative.

On the topic of youth entrepreneurship, we observed a shift in focus from high youth unemployment to a shortage of both qualified and unqualified labor. This shift calls for us to develop new programs to prevent the outflow of young, skilled workers. I recommend that the management board and program team begin planning activities to address this issue.

Finally, in the area of active youth participation in decision-making, we conducted several activities and presented the results of surveys that generated interest among key stakeholders. We hope this data will contribute to the development of future data-driven policies.

A Year in Review

In 2024, our organization advanced its mission to empower youth, drive advocacy, and build resilient communities. Through strategic partnerships and innovative approaches, we impacted thousands of young people, expanded our reach, and set the stage for future progress. This report reflects the measurable outcomes of our work and celebrates the collective efforts of our team, partners, and supporters.



Key Milestones:

Youth Employment & Digital Transition

Developed and launched a DIGI-COOP, bridging the gap between education, labor markets, and the youth sector, engaging over 1,500 young people in learning and employment opportunities from North Macedonia, Greece, & Bulgaria.

Strengthening Regional Cooperation

Established and enhanced strategic partnerships with 25 new organizations across Europe and the Western Balkans, fostering stronger cross-border collaboration on youth initiatives.

Research & Data-Driven Policy Making:

Conducted extensive research and stakeholder engagement, including surveys, focus groups, and interviews, to shape evidence-based youth policies and program development.

Capacity Building for Youth Organizations

Trained youth workers and CSOs in digitalization, advocacy, and inter-sectoral cooperation to sustain long-term youth development programs.

Policy Influence & Youth Advocacy

Organized high-impact youth-led policy dialogues leading to the adoption of key recommendations from the young people for EU integration and enlargement processes.

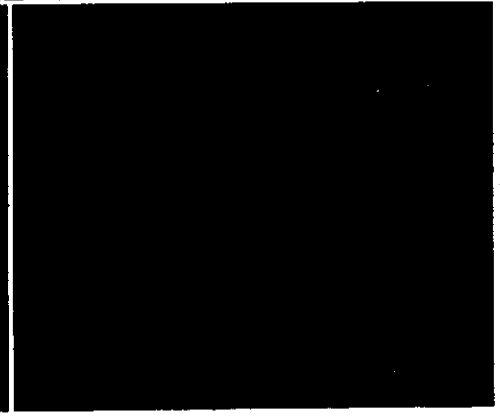
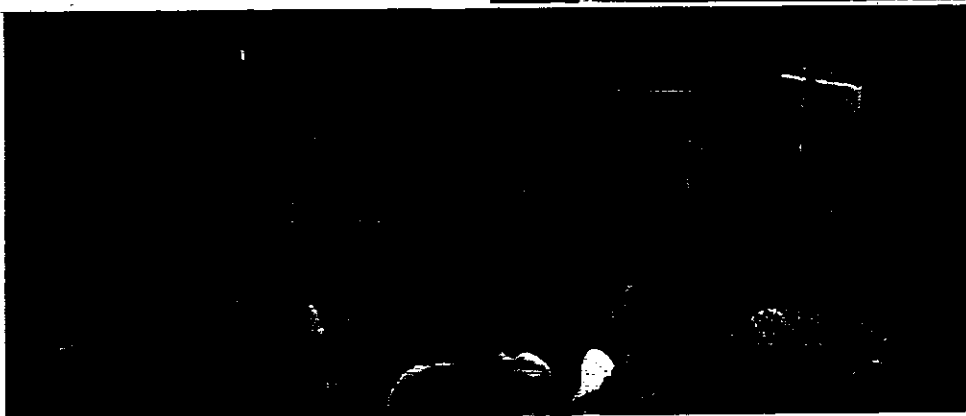
September 2024

RAISE CSOs - Resilient and Inclusive Social Entrepreneurship Pathways for Youth with local grassroots CSOs in North Macedonia

The "RAISE CSOs" project focuses on strengthening civil society organizations (CSOs) in North Macedonia by enhancing their operational capacities and fostering collaboration.



I. Developed online assessment tool

A comprehensive online assessment tool was created to evaluate the readiness of grassroots CSOs in supporting and promoting social entrepreneurship among young people;

The tool was tested with 117 CSOs and informed by a database of 202 local CSOs active across all eight planning regions in North Macedonia.



II. A detailed database was established

capturing over 200 CSOs actively engaged in social entrepreneurship at the local level. This served as the backbone for developing the assessment tool and identifying key stakeholders.

III. Comprehensive report on summarizing the readiness,

challenges, and obstacles faced by 50 local organizations in advancing social entrepreneurship.



IV. Training Toolkit designed in two phases

Good practices, case studies, and methodologies:

-A total of 5 good practice examples, 14 case studies, 8 methodologies, and 16 tools and approaches were identified and consolidated.

These resources were specifically designed for youth social enterprises, including those involving vulnerable groups.

This initiative aims to develop an innovative tool to assess how supportive cities in North Macedonia, Serbia, and Bulgaria are toward social enterprises.

Conducted comprehensive data collection and analysis to evaluate the social enterprise ecosystem in North Macedonia, Bulgaria and Serbia.

→ **International Conference "Social Entrepreneurial Ecosystem - Transform your society into a force for good"**

The event gathered 67 participants who engaged in meaningful discussions on the underdevelopment of the ecosystem, while 22 speakers shared insights from various fields essential for the growth and sustainability of social enterprises.

Projects and Initiatives

Youth Connect: A Dialogue for Peace and Security

The 'Youth Connect: A Dialogue for Peace and Security' initiative introduced a sustainable and resilient mechanism that empowered citizens to embrace non-violent, peaceful approaches to resolving conflicts and working toward shared goals. This regional initiative successfully advanced collaboration for an equitable and harmonious future.

The event took place from December 11-13, 2024, in Krusevo, North Macedonia, and brought together young leaders and stakeholders from across the region. Attendees included representatives from civil society, government, and academia, who worked collaboratively to develop a youth-led approach to peacebuilding. Aligned with the United Nations' Youth, Peace, and Security Agenda, the program fostered an inclusive environment where youth from diverse backgrounds collaborated to address conflict resolution, build trust, and promote resilient peace.



Knowledge and Strategy Sharing

- Facilitated the transfer of insights, experiences, and strategies related to youth peace and security.
- Participants explored tools such as systems thinking to navigate complex post-conflict dynamics.



Youth Engagement in Dialogue

- Young participants actively contributed to policy discussions and peacebuilding activities.
- Ensured youth perspectives were included in structured dialogues for sustainable peace.



Regional Cooperation and Best Practices

- Built upon the successful North Macedonia-Greece youth cooperation model.
- Created a cohesive interactive MAP to address both inter- and intra-country challenges.

VEBY - Virtual Exchanges for Balkan Youth

The VEBY project was designed to meet the evolving needs of young people in the digital age, drawing upon experiences from virtual mobilities during the COVID-19 period. VEBY seeks to create high-quality virtual exchange experiences for young people, particularly those with fewer opportunities, by developing digital skills, enhancing participation, and promoting the EU's opportunities beyond Programme countries.

- **Created a Manual of Good Practices** to support youth workers and educators in fostering inclusivity in digital learning environments.
- **Conducted specialized training sessions** for youth workers and educators to ensure constructive communication and engagement for young participants from diverse backgrounds.

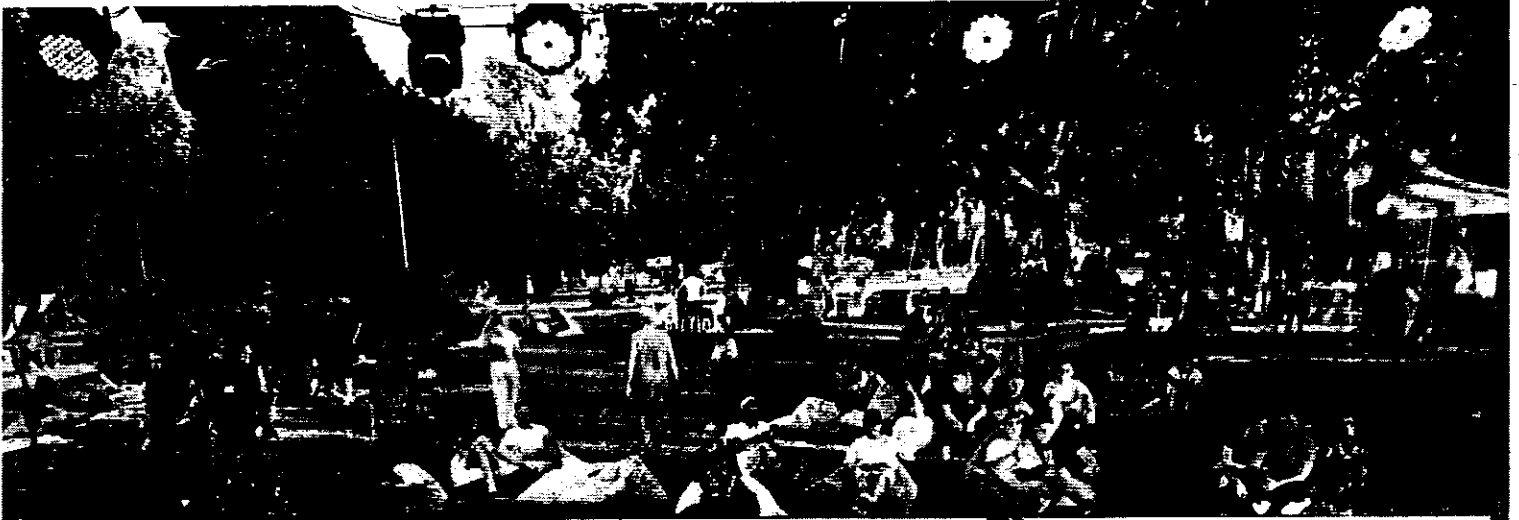

- **Supported participants in co-creating an online conference** to promote unity and civic engagement, amplifying youth voices in democratic processes.

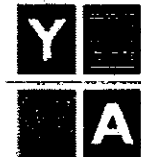

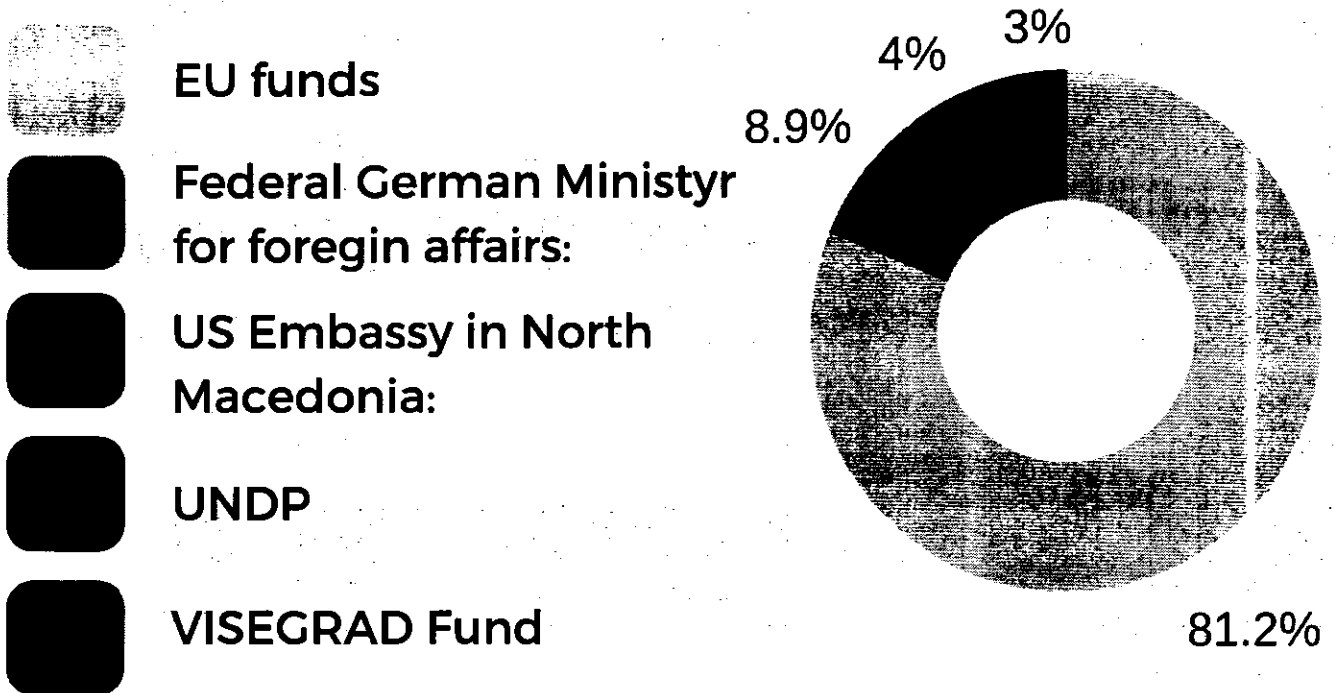

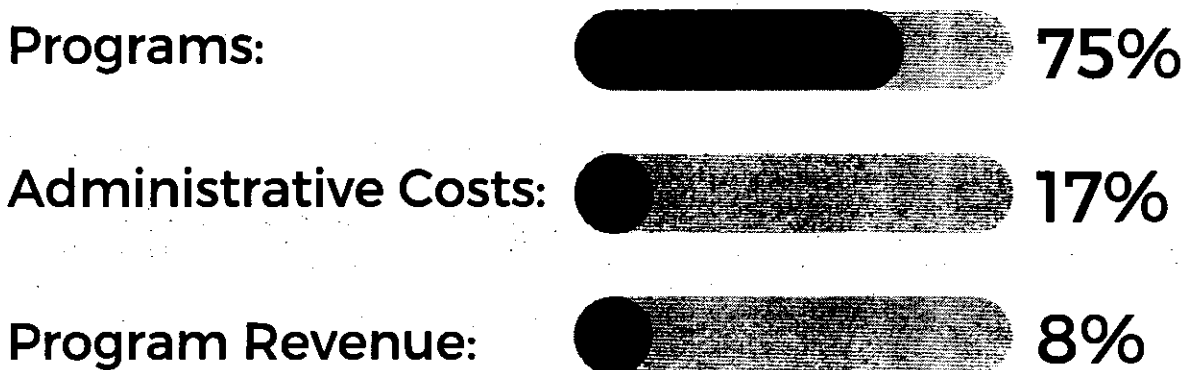


Financial Overview

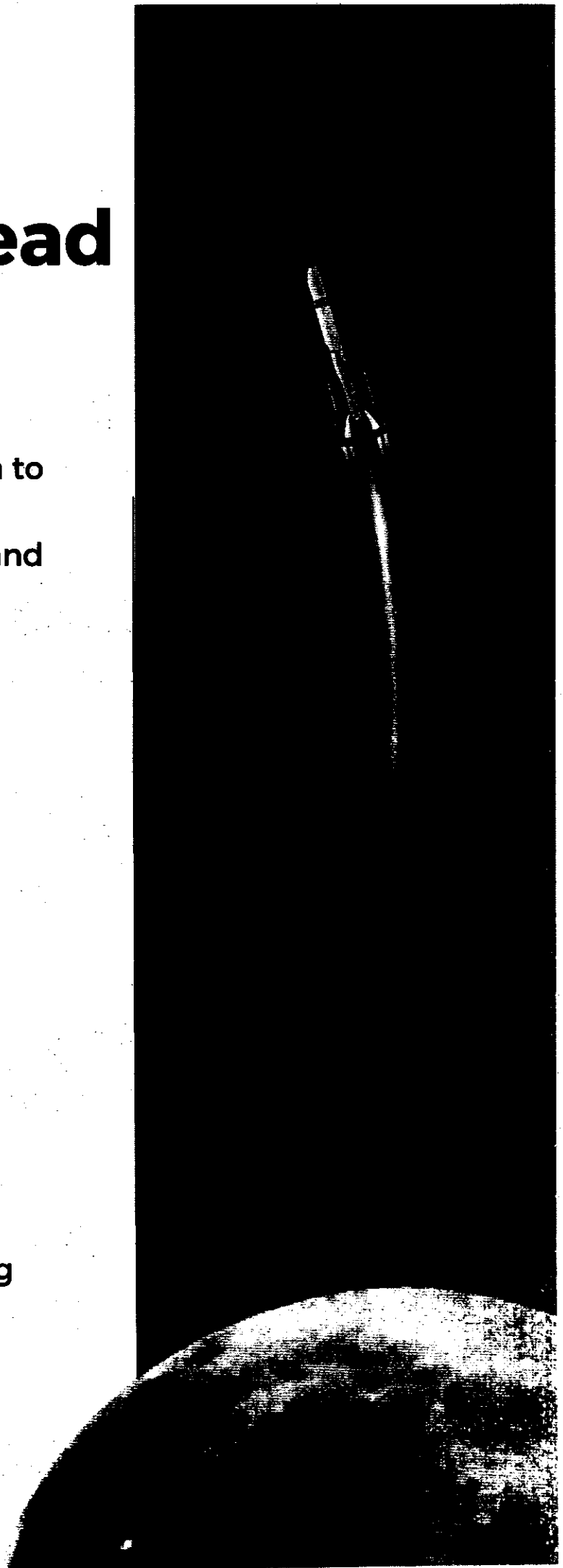
